Scheme of Evaluation: 2023-24(4th to 8th)

We would like to apprise you with **Scheme of evaluation** which is as per CBSE guidelines. It is based on CCE i.e. continuous and comprehensive evaluation.

The whole session is divided into two semester or terminals: Terminal 1/Semester1 and

Terminal 2/Semester2 for 1st to 8th.

Each Semester includes:

1) Unit test.

It includes pen paper test for all subjects except drawing. It will be taken once in a particular term in month of July/ November. Overall Weightage of UT will be 20% in classes 4th & 5th and 5% in classes 6th to 8th for final result of each particular semester.

2) PORTFOLIO:

It includes regular annual upkeep of notebooks, Scrapbook, assignments and other documents. Its Overall weightage is 5% for 3rd to 8th classes. Marks are given by subject teachers as per observation of notebooks and other related material at the end of each semester.

3) SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES (SEA's):

CD's includes cognitive development activities and RLP's is Reading language and project based activities.

<u>Cognitive development</u> (CD's) includes activities given at time of summer/ winter vacations. They are activity based on brain developing activities. It is to be done either in Holiday Homework Notebook or A4 sheet or as per directed.

<u>RLP's</u> includes activities like reading in literature(English and Hindi), ASL (assessment of listening and speaking), oral works, presentation, projects, Speaking on topics, general awareness, quiz, riddles, one word recognition, Practical's etc. They are taken time to time with prior notice. SEA's weightage for each class is given below for different classes as per given below in each particular semester

4) HALF YEARLY & YEARLY EXAMINATION
